### 1. Accounting policies

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A (Small Entities) of Financial Reporting Standard 102

#### Turnover policy

Turnover represents the value of goods and services provided in the year, excluding VAT.

#### Tangible fixed assets and depreciation policy

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided so as to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful economic lives at the following annual rates: Freehold land not depreciated. Freehold buildings at 2% straight line, Tools and equipment at 15% reducing balance, Motor vehicles at 25% reducing balance, Office equipment at 20% reducing balance to 33.3% straight line.

#### Other accounting policies

Stocks - Stock and work in progress are valued at the lower of cost and estimated net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items. Operating leases - Amounts payable under operating leases are charged to the profit and loss account as incurred. Pension costs - The company contributes to defined contribution pension schemes for eligible employees. Contributions are charged to the profit and loss account as they become payable. Deferred taxation - Deferred taxation is provided at the current rates of taxation for all material timing differences.

Creditors falling due within one year include a secured bank loan of £18,050 (2018 - £17,509) secured by a charge over the freehold property owned by the company and by a fixed and floating charge over the company's assets and undertaking.

### **4. Creditors: amounts falling due after more than one year note**

Creditors falling due after more than one year include a secured bank loan of £141,222 (2018 - £159,168) secured by a charge over the freehold property owned by the company and by a fixed and floating charge over the company's assets and undertaking. The loan is repayable by monthly instalments, of which £63,032 (2018 - £83,386) falls due after more than five years after the balance sheet date.

### **6. Related party transactions**

Dividends totalling £59,000 (2018 - £70,000) were paid to the directors of the company during the year. T E Linkhorn, director and shareholder of the company, and P D Beechinor, director of the company, are also partners in Masterfit, which carries out fitting contracts for certain goods supplied by the company.
