UPON THE APPLICATION by a Claim Form dated the 15<sup>th</sup> June 2012 of the Commissioners for Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs the Claimant and a creditor of the above named Trade 44 Ltd (hereinafter called "the Company")

AND UPON READING the evidence

AND IT APPEARING that there is no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by this Claim as appears from the Witness Statement of Scott Murphy and the exhibit thereto

AND on leave being given to amend the Claim Form to show the correct name of the Company as Trade 44 Ltd and re service being dispensed with

AND the Claimants undertaking that they will

- (A) Immediately upon restoration of the name of the company to the Register of Companies present a Petition to the Court for the compulsory winding up of the company
- (B) Inform the Register of Companies of the title and Court reference number of the said Petition immediately after issue

- (C) Inform the Registrar of Companies of the outcome of the hearing of the said Petition
- (D) Within 14 days of the making of any compulsory winding up Order in respect of the company deliver an Office Copy of that Order to the Registrar of Companies
- (E) the Claimant will unless the Company is Compulsorily Wound up in the meantime, at 6 monthly intervals from the date of this Order serve on the Registrar of Companies a full and sufficient Witness Statement setting out what steps have been taken to progress the matter

AND UPON the Claimant and the Solicitor for the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT.

- (1) the name of the above named Trade 44 Ltd be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 04782765 Ltd
- (3) an Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (4) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"

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(5) in the event that the Claimants fail to comply with undertaking (E) above the Registrar of Companies be at liberty to commence strike off action in respect of the Company without further notice to the Claimants

(6) the hearing date fixed for the 14<sup>th</sup> December 2012 be vacated
